



/ Statement on Xinjiang

SolarEdge is committed to upholding human rights in our supply chain. We aim for our suppliers to be aware of and commit to respecting human rights in their own operations and throughout their own supply chains.

Recently, we have become aware of concerns relating to abuses of human rights in the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region (XUAR) in China.

SolarEdge does not maintain manufacturing facilities in XUAR. SolarEdge sources certain materials from China, although not directly from XUAR.

However, we have contacted our key Chinese solar panel suppliers and have been assured that they have no involvement with or direct connection to activities related to human rights violations in XUAR or elsewhere.

In any event, we continue to closely monitor the situation and are committed to taking the necessary action to prevent any connection between SolarEdge and human rights abuses in China, as in any other region.
